

Position Description

The Project Manager (Policy & Constituent Engagement) for Commissioner Dexter L. McCoy will manage policy, legislative affairs, and constituent services for the residents of Precinct 4. In collaboration with the Chief of Staff, the Project Manager will ensure the advancement of the County's legislative priorities as designed based on defined needs of the community. The Project Manager will oversee constituent case management and support relevant departments in addressing gaps in access to critical county resources.

Function and Duties:

- Work directly with community stakeholders on policy and seek resources to address a variety of issues
- Serve as point of contact for the community by tracking and responding to casework correspondence, meeting with constituents and tracking constituent calls, letters, and on-line correspondence
- Provide follow-up and respond to constituent needs
- Identify constituent trends and patterns and report those patterns to make recommendations for improvements where needed
- Analyze and report outcomes and trends across the precinct and recommend areas for service improvement
- Act as legislative liaison for federal, state, and local policy needs, including seeking grant support
- Plan and manage community engagement activities, working with appropriate County offices to bring resources to the community and building participation in the community
